SUBJECT / TOPIC: Budget Amendment #1 for Fiscal Year 2025

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The City of Venice, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, adopted its fiscal year (FY) 2025 operating budget, revenues and expenses, and capital improvement program by approving Ordinance No. 2024-25 on September 24, 2024 for \$180,113,955. The City Council can amend the budget as necessary throughout the year by adopting an amending ordinance in the same manner as the original budget adoption.

The FY2024 budget was increased by certain encumbrances (\$34,346,468) and project balances (\$27,889,513) rolled forward from FY2024. Encumbrances represent the balances on certain purchase orders at September 30, 2024. Project balances are when a project has been approved in FY2024, but a contract has not been finalized or encumbered.

In addition, certain additional expenses were not anticipated at the time the original FY2025 budget was adopted or amended. The City desires to amend its FY2025 adopted budget by \$8,350,500. \$400,000 of this amount is appropriate funds for FEMA public assistance advisory services for Hurricanes Helene and Milton, \$5,850,000 is for disaster debris removal and monitoring for Hurricane Milton as identified on the attached memo from the Director of Public Works, \$3,000,000 is to appropriate additional funds needed for the Intercoastal 2nd Force Main Project, \$937,500 is to be unappropriated from the FY2025 budget since the ASR well project is cancelled as identified on the attached memo from the Utilities Director, \$38,000 is to appropriate funds for a vehicle as identified on the attached memo from the Fleet Manager. The proposed amended budget for FY2025 is \$250,700,436 as shown in the schedule on page 2.

SUBJECT: Budget Amendment FY 2025 – Intracoastal Second Force Main and Aquifer Storage

Recovery Well

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Utilities Department received bids on October 25, 2024 for the Intracoastal Second Force Main project and is recommending the Finance Department take the necessary steps to enter into a contract with, Spectrum Underground, Inc., at a total cost of \$4,147,547. This is one of the Utilities Department's most vital projects for maintaining reliable sewer service to Venice Island and avoid associated environmental impacts from sewer overflows. The Department is requesting an additional \$3,000,000 to complete the project with funding via a State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan of \$2.250,000 and State appropriations of \$750,000.

In addition, as part of the Capital Improvement Plan, the department was in the process of contracting the construction of the Aquifer Storage Recovery Well. It has been determined it is not in the City's best interest to proceed with this project. Therefore, we request to unappropriate \$937,500 of expenses and the corresponding SRF loan.

We respectfully request approval of the budget amendment.

SUBJECT / TOPIC: Budget Amendment to Replace Fire Inspector Fleet Unit

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Vehicle unit 159, a Ford Explorer was held back from being sent to auction to provide as a vehicle for the new additional Fire Inspector. After being sent to the shop for repairs multiple times for mechanical and electrical failures, it is the Fleet Manager's decision to replace this unit. The Fire Department has accumulated funds in the Fleet Replacement program that can go toward this vehicle's replacement and add the new unit to the Fleet Schedule. We will be sending this vehicle to auction for sale "AS IS", because the vehicle still has market value. We have a quote for a replacement vehicle from a preferred vendor that uses State and National contracts for \$33,584 and we will need to add approximately an additional \$4,400 in upfitting for this unit to have it ready for service.
