SUBJECT / TOPIC: Review Historic and Architectural Preservation Board Recommendation for City Council approve listing the Venice Beach Pavilion at 101 S. The Esplanade in the Local Register of Historic Resources

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

At the February 13, 2025 Historic and Architectural Preservation Board (HAPB) meeting, the HAPB approved the following motion:

A motion was made by Mr. Barick, seconded by Ms. Dearybury, that based on review of the application materials, the staff report and testimony provided during the public hearing, the Historic and Architectural Preservation Board finds this petition consistent with the Comprehensive Plan, in compliance with the Land Development Code and with the affirmative Findings of Fact in the record, recommends to City Council approval of Nomination to the Local Register for 101 The Esplanade South, also known as the Venice Beach Pavilion. - 4. Embody the distinctive characteristics of a type, period, style or method of construction or work of a master; or possess high artistic value; or represent a distinguishable entity whose components may lack individual distinction.
