STRATEGIC PLAN GOAL: Preserve the Venice Quality of Life through Proper Planning

SUBJECT: Listing of 640 W. Venice Avenue to the Local Register of Historic Places

Background: At the March 18, 2022 Historic Preservation Board (HPB) meeting, the HPB made the following motion:

Recommend to City Council Listing the Property at 640 W. Venice Avenue on the Local Register of Historic Places.

This recommendation is based upon the property meeting the criteria described in Chapter 86-28, (c) (2) a. 1 and 3.

- 1. Are associated with distinctive elements of cultural, social, political, economic, scientific, religious, prehistoric and architectural history that have contributed to the pattern of history in the community, the city, the state or the nation.
- 3. Embody the distinctive characteristics of a type, period, style or method of construction or work of a master; or possess high artistic value; or represent a distinguishable entity whose components may lack individual distinction.

The property meets criteria 1 as it is one of the earliest—if not the earliest—example of the midcentury ranch style in Venice. This style became popular during the post-WWII construction boom that took place throughout the country and especially in Florida.

The property meets criteria 3 as it is a pristine and well preserved example of the mid-century ranch. It has retained the architectural features and construction type typical of the era. This includes: wood floor beamns and joists supporting a a subfloor over a crawlspace, gable roofs, painted concrete block, and awning windows.

To continue the process, a public hearing before City Council must be scheduled within 90 days of this motion.
