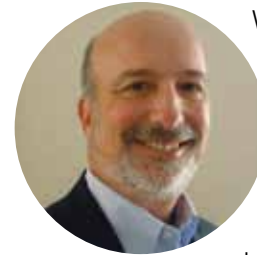
I am happy to report our Agency will begin to continue our connection with our Littles until they are 21 years old.

A Message from the Board Chair

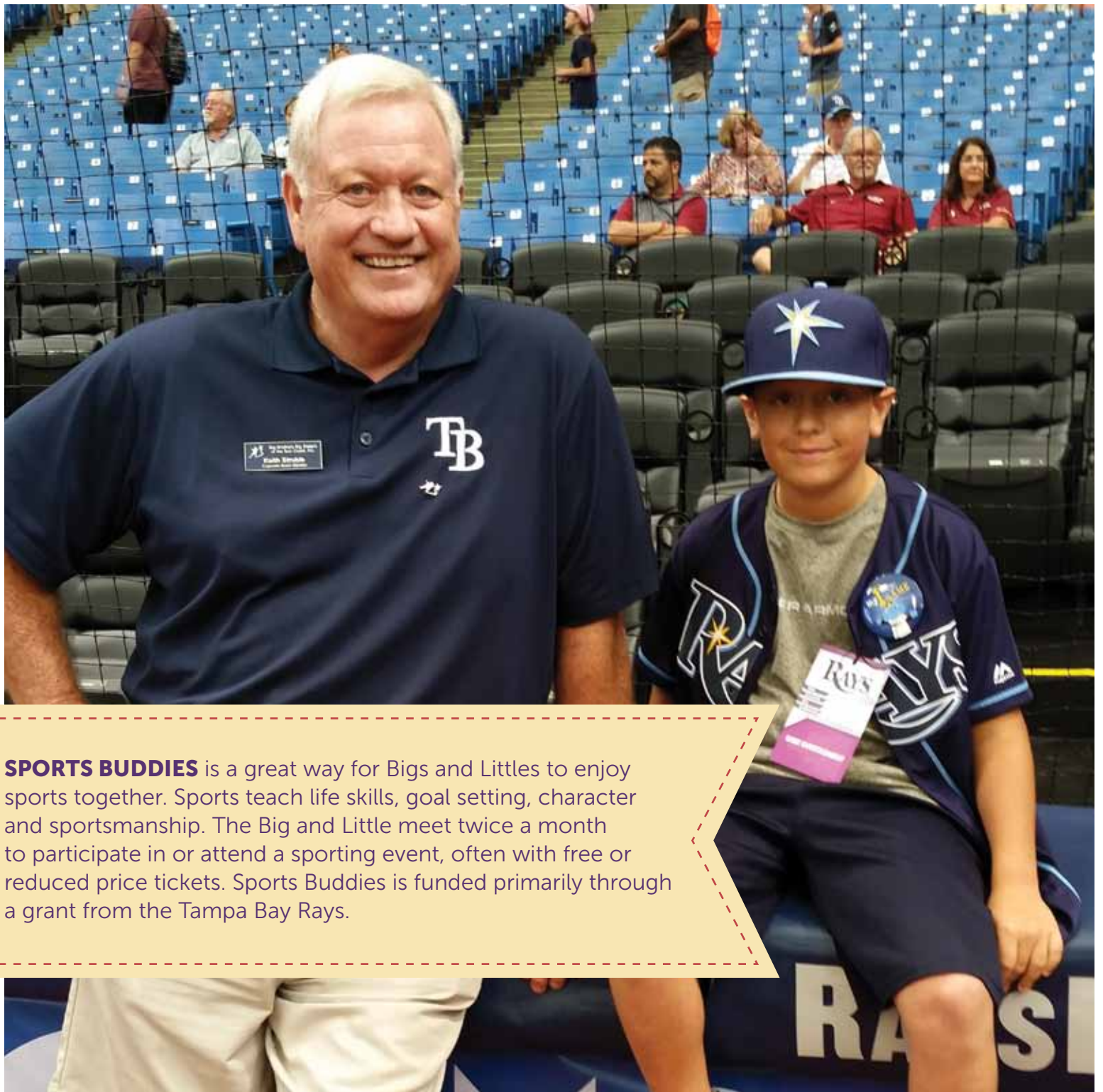

Reading Bigs

The program fosters a love of literature with elementary school children while improving their reading comprehension skills. Using a curriculum, based on the Common Core standards, the mentor works to improve reading comprehension by reading aloud, discussing stories and completing activities based around interpreting literature.

To support at-risk students as they transition from middle school to high school, a series of "success" activities focuses on academic support, self-esteem, motivation and career awareness.

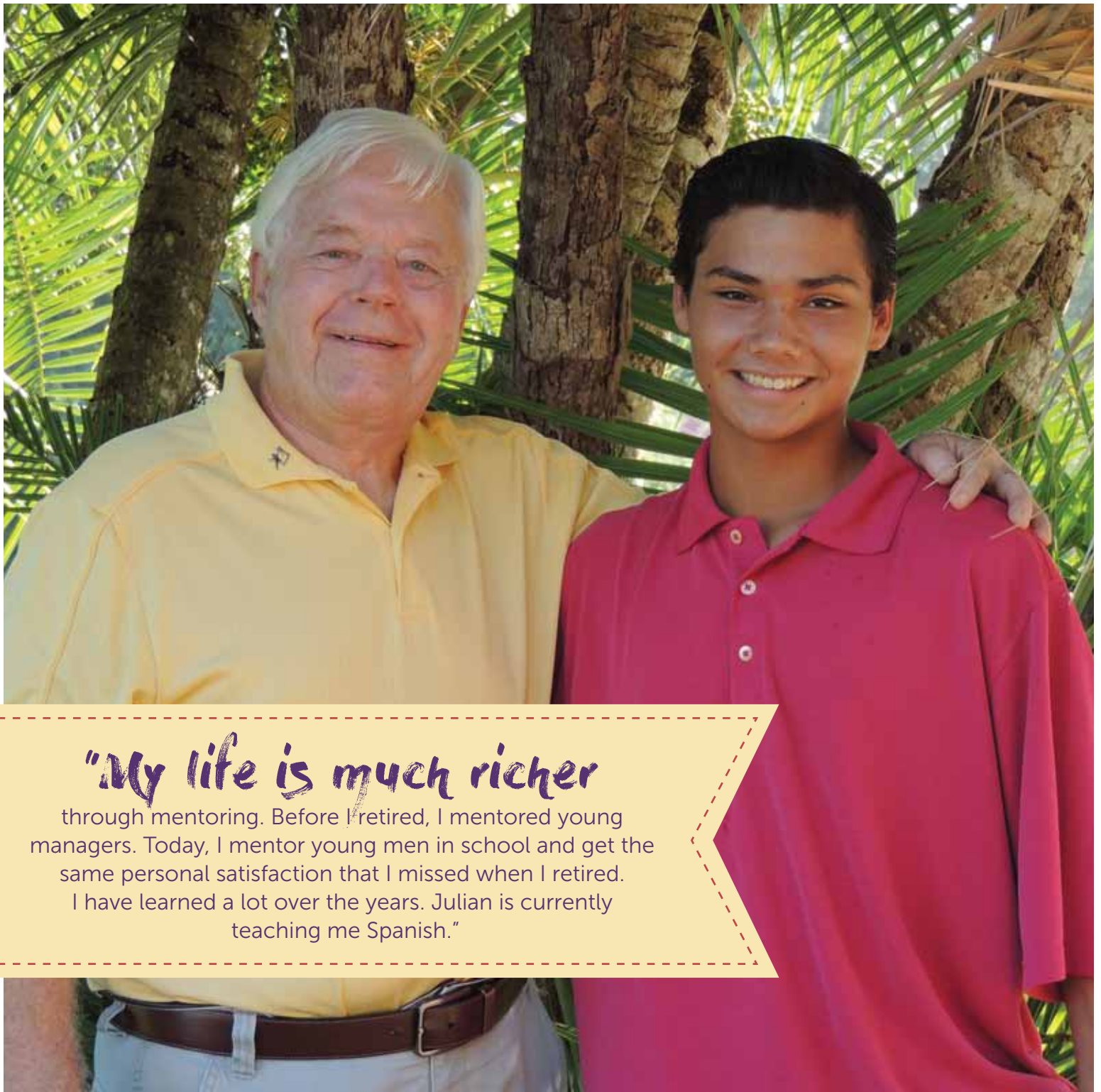

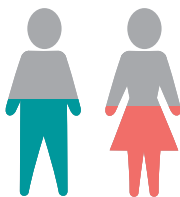

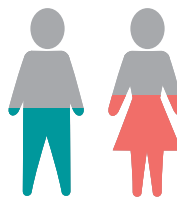
