NO. 2024-11 An Ordinance of the City of Venice, Florida, Amending the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 87, Land Development Code, by Amending Section 3.7.5., Parking Lot Landscaping Requirements, and Section 3.7.6., Miscellaneous Landscaping, Pursuant to Text Amendment Petition No. 24-16AM, to Reduce the Required Square Footage of Landscape Area of Interior Parking Areas Within the Mixed Use Seaboard Area, and to Revise the Requirements for Landscaping Adjacent to a Right-Of-Way Without Off-Street Parking; Providing for Repeal of All Ordinances in Conflict Herewith; Providing for Severability; and Providing an Effective Date
