Police for Fiscal Years 2026 - 2028

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The city's Police Officers are represented by the Florida State Lodge Fraternal Order of Police, Inc. (FOP(O)). The current collective bargaining agreement between the city and FOP (O) is effective October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2025. Terms and conditions of employment for the period commencing October 1, 2025 have been agreed upon, reflected in a proposed collective bargaining agreement covering the period October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026. The proposed agreement has been ratified by the FOP(O) membership. It is the recommendation of the management collective bargaining team that you approve the proposed agreement.

In summary, the main changes are as follows:
