### Traffic Control/Construction Phasing

#### In General:

- Construction will occur from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Saturday
- Some nighttime work will be necessary
- Single lane closures may occur throughout the project area
- Some temporary full closures may occur after 10 p.m.
- Phasing construction on Miami and Tampa avenues to minimize impacts to parking

This sequence of work and schedule is subject to change due to weather and unforeseen underground conditions.

#### Construction Schedule


#### **Contract Days:**

- 17 days of time extension granted for:
  - WEATHER— Contractor has worked thru a very wet Aug and Sept without requesting additional days. Although productions were slowed tremendously, work was still ongoing while other projects shut down
  - ADDITIONAL WORK ADDED TO CONTRACT
    - Sidewalk, curb, conduit, storm drainage






# Original Anticipated Construction Sequence as of June 22, 2018



#### **Proposed City of Venice Downtown Construction Phasing** Single lane closures should be expected throughout the project area. Crews may be working in more than one area at a time. # Original Anticipated Construction Sequence as of October 12, 2018







#### Original vs. Current Construction Sequence

- Full completion remains March 2019
- Miami schedule remains the same (some work done earlier than scheduled)
- Miami sequenced by block to minimize effects of construction in front of businesses
- Tampa Avenue likely to be constructed in segments like Miami Avenue

# What takes so long? (Sequence of work)

Work activities must be done one at a time. Crews cannot all work in the same place simultaneously. Once a crew completes work on one segment, they move to another segment/street to continue working, and to stay on the project.

- Silva (tree) cell installation
- Removal/Replacement of curb
- Removal/Replacement of sidewalk
- Irrigation installation
- Electrical installation
- Landscape installation
- Paver installation
- Milling/Resurfacing of roadway
- Finish work



# What takes so long? (Special accommodations)

What is the Project Team doing to assist businesses/visitors?

- Providing crosswalk access when safe
  - Many issues with pedestrians walking through work zone causing unsafe conditions.
- Making accommodations for special events
  - Stopping work early
- Re-sequencing activities to open areas to the public

Additional time and effort needed for these accommodations



### Advancing the Schedule

#### Completed early

- Completed underground drainage on EB and WB W. Venice Avenue
- Completed underground drainage on Miami Avenue on 300 block, Nassau Street, and Nokomis Avenue

#### How to expedite project

- Rescheduling of sub-contractors
- Advance work on other segments of the project – start on WB W. Venice Avenue this week (October 22)

#### Downtown Roadway Improvements Project

The City's contractor, Quality Enterprises USA Inc., begins construction in July 2018 to reconstruct Tampa, Venice and Miami avenues between U.S. 41 Business and Harbor Drive. Work includes stormwater improvements, new landscaping, and installation of new sidewalk and streetscape amenities. The contractor will also mill and resurface the roadways. Estimated substantial completion is February 2019.
