Whereas, Venice deeply appreciates the important contributions the public works department has made to our city and to the unique qualities of our community; and

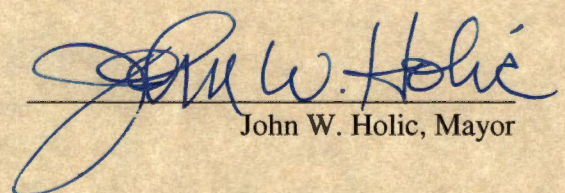
