
• The 500 to 700 blocks of West Venice Avenue


CRITERIA

- Road must have 50% canopy cover
- Road must have 75% Florida Friendly species

Complete descriptions of standards and requirements for Canopy Roads are detailed in the *Land Development Code, Chapter 89 – Sec. 3.4.9 Canopy Road Designation*.









CANOPY ROAD PROTECTION ZONE (CRPZ)

The CRPZ is defined as:

A designated section of City and county right-ofway and the adjacent private property extending up to 15 feet laterally from the right-of-way onto adjacent private property, but in no event extending greater than 15 feet laterally from the edge of the roadway.



Tree Protection Standards affecting adjacent property owners:

- Pruning: Permits required for branches over two inches, supervised by a Certified Arborist.
- Root Pruning: Must follow industry standards and be supervised by a Certified Arborist.
- Violations: Causing irreparable injury or improper pruning within the CRPZ is prohibited.



Request:

- We respectfully request that Council designate the proposed section of West Venice Avenue as a Canopy Road; and
- To waive fees for pruning permits within the Canopy Road Protection Zone
