One-Cent Infrastructure Sales Tax

A one-cent tax applied to the first \$5,000 of any single taxable item at the time of purchase.

Proceeds from the surtax are used to invest in capital improvement projects for the County, the School District and the municipalities.



Surtax Referendum History

Surtax I – 1990 thru 1999

First approved by voters in 1989 for the period of 1990 thru 1999 (10 years)

Surtax II - 2000 thru 2009

Extended by voters in 1997 for the period of 2000 thru 2009 (10 years)

Surtax III - 2010 to 2024

Extended by voters in 2007 for the period of 2010 thru 2024 (15 years)

Nov. 2022

Potential Surtax IV referendum, to continue tax for another 15 years, from 2025 thru 2039.

Dec 31, 2024

Surtax Phase III expires

Purpose of Surtax Referendum

To continue a one-cent sales tax that has been in place for more than 30 years

Process

- Projects Based on Long-Term Revenue <u>Projections</u> from the County, Over a 15 year period, (Jan 2025-Dec 2039)
- Total Project Costs are Estimates, Subject to Change Over Time
- Actual Projects are Subject to Change Over Time, Updated Periodically
- Projects Each Year Will be Based on Available Funding
- Each Project Will Continue to Be Approved Each Fiscal Year During the CIP and Budget Process



Process

- City Council Adopts Resolution Containing a Projects List ("Exhibit A')
- City of Venice's "Exhibit A" of Resolution will be Incorporated into the County-Wide One Cent Infrastructure Surtax Ordinance

 - Parks and Recreation (includes Beach Renourishment)
