V. PRESENTATIONS

Mariah Justice, Certified Local Government Coordinator, Florida Department of State Division of Historical Resources: Presentation on the Certified Local Government Program (10 min.)

Ms. Justice provided a presentation on the CLG program to include grant funding, support, education, benefits, the National Register, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) variances, local tax credit programs, responsibilities, and resources. She answered Council questions regarding cost, revisions of ordinance, review of amendments, and merging the architectural review and historic preservation boards.

Martin Black, Certified Planner, Land and P-3 Advisors: Presentation on Future Use of the Six Acre Parcel Located at 210 Laurel Oaks Road, Nokomis, Florida (10 min.)

Mr. Black questioned the future use of the six acre parcel located at 210 Laurel Oaks Road, Nokomis, and requested a list of other properties the City owns.

City Manager Lavallee answered Council questions regarding the property and indicated the City owns one other parcel that is 39 acres noting 15 acres of it will house the booster station for the Utilities Department. He also answered questions regarding possible City uses for the six acre parcel.

Mr. Black noted his organization will come before Council with a formal request or application.

Michael Sollitto, Chief Operations Officer, Habitat for Humanity South
Sarasota County: Request to Release Parcel Restrictions on the Two Acre
Parcel Located at 749 Knights Trail Road, Nokomis, Florida (10 min.)

<u>22-5426</u> Kara Morgan, Chief Executive Officer, Venice MainStreet Inc.: Annual Report (10 min)

Ms. Morgan and Tracy Silver, Board President, Venice MainStreet, provided their Annual Report, including their mission, staff, board of directors, organization focus, events, 2021 highlights, social media and marketing reach, financials, and volunteers. She expressed appreciation for continued support, and answered Council questions regarding the strategic plan and report.

<u>22-5427</u> Tom Jones, Chair of the Environmental Advisory Board: Board's Annual Report and Council Feedback (10 min.)

Mr. Jones provided the board's annual report and answered Council questions regarding city liaisons, guidance on the strategic plan, Land Development Regulations (LDRs), and floating islands.

Mayor Feinsod requested a report of the Environmental Advisory Board's (EAB) recommendations given, and those that were accepted and rejected by the Planning Commission for the LDRs. He also asked for the EAB to bring to Council the water quality expert and recommendations that the Planning Commission did not accept. No Council action was taken on this request.

22-5428 Roger Effron, Chair of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board: Board's Annual Report and Council Feedback (10 min.)

Mr. Effron provided the board's annual report for the year. Dr. Fiedler informed him that the Planning Commission would be requesting the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board to finalize and adopt the master parks plan. No Council action was taken on this.

Ms. Trammell provided the board's annual report.

Dr. Fiedler gave feedback regarding parks and signage. She requested a plan for the gateways to the historic districts, and recommended working in conjunction with the City Engineer and partnering with the Parks and

Recreation Advisory Board and Venice MainStreet. No Council action was taken on this.
