Amendment to LU 4.1.1, Figure LU-13

On February 15, 2022, the Planning Commission made the following motion for the subject petition:

The motion was **APPROVED** by a vote of 6-0:

Based on review of the application materials, the staff report and testimony provided during the public hearing, the Planning Commission, sitting as the local planning agency, finds this petition consistent with the Comprehensive Plan and in compliance with Florida Statutes Chapter 163, Part II, and therefore, RECOMMENDS TO CITY COUNCIL APPROVAL OF COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENT PETITION NO. 21-64CP, with the addition that the maximum building height of the GCCF PUD may be up to 55 feet if granted by City Council, and un-striking the 42 feet.

*NOTE to Clerk: The original request made by the applicant was amended as you can see in the above motion. No changes have been made to the staff report, but the Comprehensive Plan replacement pages have been changed to match the motion.

To continue the processing of the petition, please complete the following:

- Schedule the public hearings before City Council and provide our office with the legal advertisement when you send it to the Gondolier. This amendment requires the State's expedited review process which includes a transmittal hearing (1st reading) before City Council, then transmittal to the Florida State Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO). Once is it reviewed by the DEO and other State agencies, it will be returned for a City Council adoption hearing (2nd reading). The adopted amendment will then be transmitted to the DEO for their records.
