**SUBJECT / TOPIC**: Budget Amendment #4 for Fiscal Year 2023

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**: The City of Venice, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, adopted its fiscal year (FY) 2023 operating budget, revenues and expenses, and capital improvement program by approving Ordinance No. 2022-26 on September 26, 2022 for \$144,139,472. The City Council can amend the budget as necessary throughout the year by adopting an amending ordinance in the same manner as the original budget adoption.

The FY2023 budget was increased by certain encumbrances (\$19,406,713) and project balances (\$38,433,391) rolled forward from FY2022. Encumbrances represent the balances on certain purchase orders at September 30, 2022. Project balances are when a project has been approved in FY2022, but a contract has not been finalized (or encumbered. The Fiscal Year 2023 budget was amended by approving Ordinance No. 2023-01 on January 24, 2023 for \$4,983,131, by approving Ordinance No. 2023-08 on March 28, 2023 for \$6,486,955, and by approving Ordinance No. 2023-20 on June 27, 2023 for \$3,583,512, said budget as amended being \$217,033,174.

In addition, certain additional expenses were not anticipated at the time the original FY2023 budget was adopted or amended. The City desires to amend its FY2023 adopted budget by \$670,949. \$150,000 of this amount is to appropriate additional park impact fee funds for the croquet expansion at Wellfield Park as identified on the attached memo from the City Engineer, and \$520,949 is to appropriate additional funds for the design of the Tarpon Center Upgrades project as identified on the attached memo from the City Engineer. The proposed amended budget for FY2023 is \$217,704,123 as shown in the schedule on page 2.

SUBJECT / TOPIC: Croquet Expansion at Wellfield Park – Budget Amendment

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**: Sarasota County has added \$150,000 in South County Park Impact Fees for a total funded amount of \$350,000 as illustrated in Sarasota County Project #93125 Adopted Budget and the Locally Funded Agreement (LFA) approved by City Council on 4/25/2023 and adopted by Sarasota County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) on 5/9/2023. In accordance with a separate agreement with the Sarasota County Croquet Club (SCCC) approved by City Council on 4/25/2023, SCCC will contract all work with eligible costs submitted to the City for reimbursement from the LFA funds. Expansion of the Croquet Fields at Wellfield Park is included in the City's FY2023 Adopted Budget for \$200,000. This budget amendment request adds the \$150,000 funded by South County Park Impact Fees as income and expense line items within the City budget.

SUBJECT / TOPIC: Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Grant Agreement –

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**: The Tarpon Center Nature Based Flood Mitigation Pilot Project was identified in the Resilience Plan completed in April 2021. The Tarpon Center project elevates the existing seawall to protect the evacuation route in response to high tides and storm surge impacts that limit travel in the roadway. In addition, living shoreline and water quality improvements are included in the project. Based on the project parameter, an initial grant application was approved by FDEP for \$625,000. Additional grant funds of \$950,000 were approved by FDEP in the State Budget adopted July 1, 2023. Both grant appropriations are 50/50 match.

The Tarpon Center Project has been combined with utilities upgrades scheduled within the corridor to improve efficiency and cost effectiveness. A large project design agreement has been negotiated with Ardurra for the overall project design as the Engineer of Record for the Utilities Department. The design portion for resiliency and road/sidewalk portions of the project totals \$670,949; with \$394,163 allocated to resiliency and \$276,786 to street/sidewalk/multi-modal. Only \$150,000 was appropriated in FY2023 for design. An additional \$520,949 needs to be appropriated in FY2023 for the total cost of the design which is included in Budget Amendment #4 for FY2023.

The Grant Agreement Amendment in the amount of \$950,000 will be provided to City Council for approval on consent at a future meeting and amounts will be reflected on the "Memo – Changes from June Budget Workshop" and included in the FY2024 Final Adopted Budget.
