Annual Funding Request  
Venice Beach Maintenance Nourishment Project

### **Background:**

The City of Venice has an existing funding agreement with FDEP to provide State grant funds for the Venice Beach Nourishment Project. Consistent with the FDEP funding agreement, a resolution is required to be executed by the City of Venice on an annual basis authorizing the submittal of an Application for State Funds to the FDEP, Office of Beaches and Coastal Systems, for the Florida Beach Erosion Control Program Budget for Fiscal Year 2017/2018 for the Venice Beach Nourishment Project and any required post construction beach and environmental monitoring. This program provides cost sharing with FDEP for the local portion of the beach nourishment project. The majority of the beach nourishment funding comes from federal funds provided by the Army Corp of Engineers based on the erosion impacts to the beach due to the historical installation of the Venice Inlet.
