Request for Affected Person Status

Information regarding Affected Person Status:

- All members of the public have the opportunity to speak under the audience participation section of a public hearing. You do not need to file a Request for Affected Person Status to be allowed to speak at the public hearing.
- If granted affected person status, you will have the same opportunity as the applicant to present evidence and testimony and to cross-examine witnesses for the applicant, City, and any other party. You may also be crossexamined by the City, applicant, or any other party.
- To be eligible for affected person status you must submit this application to the City Clerk, including all appropriate documentation, at least three (3) business days prior to the public hearing.
- Your status as an affected person will be determined at the public hearing. Staff does not have any part in the
 determination.
- You must be present at the public hearing concerning the matter in which you are seeking affected person status
- The granting of affected person status by the Planning Commission does not guarantee City Council will grant
 affected person status. A new request will need to be timely submitted to the City Clerk's office prior to the
 public hearing before City Council.
- The granting of affected person status is limited to the land use petition at issue. If a subsequent petition is
 filed for the same property, affected person status will need to be requested again prior to the public hearing.
 For example, the granting of affected person status for a zoning map amendment does not mean you
 automatically have affected person status for a preliminary plat or site & development plan petition for the
 same property.

Request for Affected Person Status

My wife and I spend much of our leisure time sitting out on our lanai. We especially enjoy sitting out in the evenings when our view to the southwest is of a pond, vegetation, and the sky with its sunsets and stars. If the commercial center is approved our view of sunsets and nighttime stars will be significantly diminished by the parking lot lights which will be approximately 38-40 feet tall and will be on all night. We are also close enough to the intersection of Laurel Road and Jacaranda Boulevard that we will hear significantly more traffic than we do currently. Our quality of life will be significantly more affected than that of other people living in this area of Venice.
