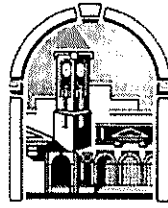

The following Resume' with Honors has been edited with a partial listing:

Richard Bergmann is a graduate of the University of Illinois School of Architecture with additional studies in conservation of building materials at the University of York, York, England, and Cornell College.

"Showing a sympathetic understanding of the relation between building and urban setting and between old and new, Richard Bergmann's sensitive and skillful handling of creative design and adaptive preservation is noteworthy" according to investiture into the College of Fellows of The American Institute of Architects (AIA) for outstanding contribution to the architectural profession, 1982. It is a life-long honor granted to fewer than 10% of its membership.

Served for 27 years as Chair of a local historic district commission (New Canaan, Connecticut). "Because of the excellent persuasive ability of Dick Bergmann, the Red Cross decided not to encase their house in either vinyl or aluminum. It is now being painted," proudly wrote Dr. Jerome Selinger, former chair of the New Canaan Historic District Commission, July 31, 1979, meeting minutes.

30-year Trustee of local historic society, a founding member of the Connecticut Trust for Historic Preservation, founder of Green-Link---a greenway/walking paths, now part of a Connecticut Land Trust, similar to the Greens/Mini Parks in the Nolen/Venice Master Plan. First recipient of the AIA of Connecticut's Outstanding Service in Historic Preservation to the Community award, 1994, cited for "selfless dedication to preserving Connecticut's architectural and cultural heritage."

When departing his home town after 45 years, he was honored with the New Canaan Preservation Alliance's 2018 Leadership Recognition Award prior to establishing residency in Venice.

A frequent speaker, published writer and a professional photographer in historic preservation, landscape, and the environment. In between, he is a sculptor and has a strong sense of stewardship for something larger.

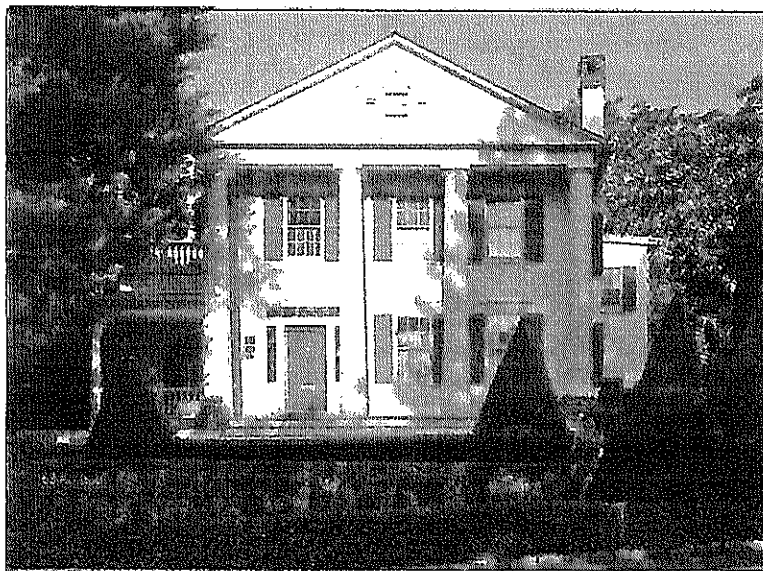

Town landmark changes hands as Bergmanns head south

For 45 years Dick and Sandra Bergmann have lived in and lovingly cared for one of New Canaan's most treasured landmarks — the stunning Greek Revival style home at 63 Park Street at the corner of Seminary near God's Acre. It's not just the distinguished house that attracts attention. It's also the extraordinarily beautiful, meticulously groomed landscape that surrounds it on all sides. Documented in the Archives of American Gardens, it is part of the Smithsonian Institution's Horticulture Services Division, sponsored by The Garden Club of New Canaan.

The Bergmanns recently sold the home and will be starting an exciting new chapter in their lives in a carefully researched community which they describe as New Canaan South — the island of Venice, Fla., near
