## 1. PUBLIC HEARING DATES AND SETTING MILLAGE RATE

Council is required to submit, prior to August 4, 2013, a preliminary millage figure and the actual date, time, and place for required public hearings on the budget. The hearings must be held after 5:00 p.m. and state law prohibits the city from holding its public hearings on the same dates as the county (September 9 and 23) or school board (September 10).

Staff is recommending the budget public hearings be scheduled for Tuesday, September 3 and Tuesday, September 17, both beginning at 5:01 p.m.

The preliminary millage and the date of the first public hearing will become a part of the TRIM (Truth in Millage) bill notice. The preliminary millage may be lowered (but not increased) at either or both of the public hearings. Staff will recommend a preliminary millage figure during the presentation.
