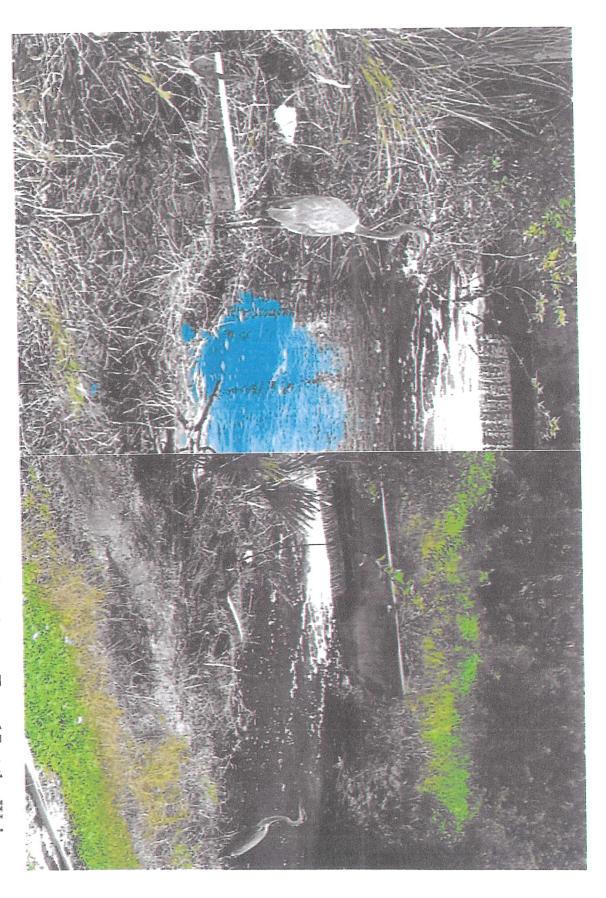

Tract 17 It is part of an interrelated, integrated, communally dependent ecosystem

Tract 17's rectangular 8 acres are an ideal combination of grassy plains, thickly populated mature trees, and intertwined underbrush that are uniquely positioned for Sandhill Cranes, Heron and others use for shelter and protection. It is a perfectly located and nurturing oasis for this and other reasons

100% of 203 acres of water flow through our mutual wetlands, open channel and its singular weir, providing an abundant food source for wildlife. Small fish are carried through or trapped by the retention wall of the weir by the water flow, or are displaced into the shallow pond area between the weir and the culvert, providing a steady, excellent source of available food for the birds that frequent Tract 17

Aquatic birds, turtles, alligators, raccoons, and other fauna are drawn there to feed, rest and shelter.

The combination of the attraction of the freshwater ponds and surrounding diminishing habitat has evolved Tract 17 into being a natural sheltered sanctuary with immediate adjacency to the North Lake boundary.

The area, farmlands in the 1980's, is also now home to multiple tree species in excess of 35 feet in height and 36 inches in girth.

The combination of isolation, shelter, food and adjacency to the ponds are an essential consideration in this petition. Please refer to attached photos

Additionally, the planned expansion of Knights Trail Road parallel to Tract 17 would pre-emptively give Sarasota County a strategic advantage in possessing and regulating the land and parsing out the apportioned quadrant required for expansion, short yards from our weir, wetlands and singular culvert that handles all water exiting under Knights Tails Road

I petition this council to consider all of the aforementioned with the backdrop of what is happening to the natural beauty of Florida, anchored by our fauna, flora and visual attributes, for all of us in an anticipatory manner reverse the vanishing natural footprint for multiple species to go about their natural lives, shelter, reproduce, and successfully raise their hatchlings.

Please note the use of the phrase "COULD BE SEEN" as opposed to "WOULD BE SEEN" - Conjecture vs Obligation

In Bullet Points -

- 1) Toscana Isles has 969 residences in immediate proximity to 203 acres of water retention ponds within its boundaries
- 2) The ponds are designed not only to accept rainwater from our property but runoff from properties immediately south AND east of us
- 3) Myaaka River overflow drains from its banks flowing north towards us in fact Laurel Road immediately south of us has had multiple City issued flood warnings and actual events within recent memory
- 4) There will be ongoing paving of lands and increased water flow into our water retention ponds as development continues

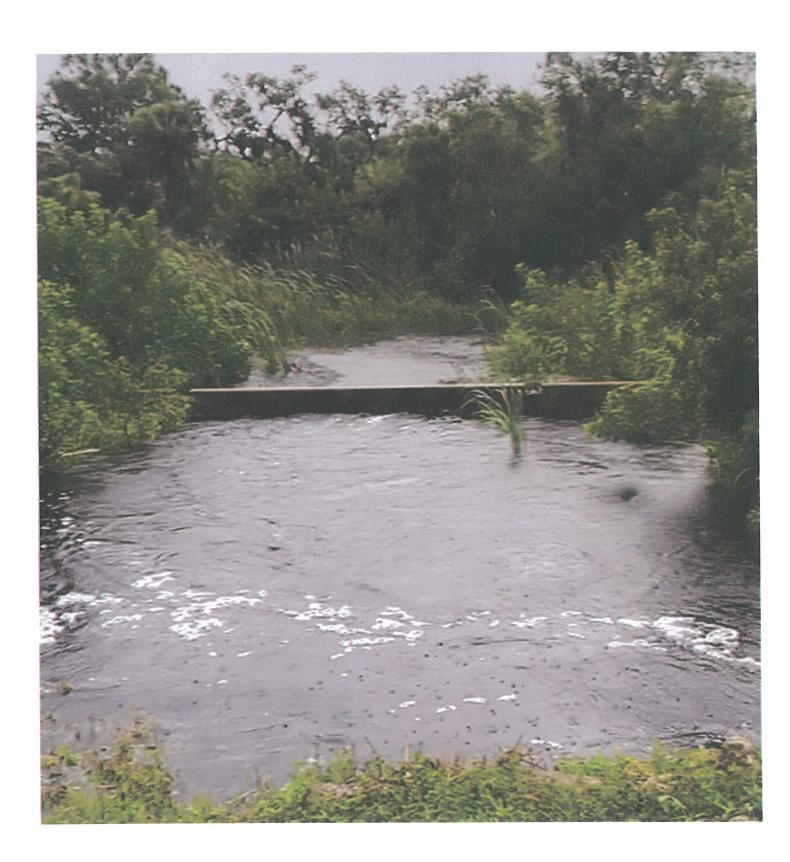

1) A fully laden Cement Truck weighs anywhere from 63,000 to 72,000 pounds. Travelling at 35 mph, calculating average weight of 67,500 pounds, an AI generated answer is as follows "Under ideal conditions, it would take a large commercial vehicle weighing 67,500 pounds approximately 6.87 seconds to stop from 35 mph, accounting for both reaction and braking time. In ideal conditions, an alert driver in a 67,500-pound commercial vehicle traveling at 35 mph would need approximately **220 feet** to come to a complete stop. This is significantly longer than the stopping distance for a passenger car due to the vehicle's immense weight."

And that does not account for fine sand or gravel on the road from these trucks, inclement weather, darkness or a combination of all threeA car weighing 3,500 pounds would stop @ 100 to 125 ft depending on ideal conditions for comparison

- 1 There is no traffic light on the corner less than 500 feet from the exit, which has innate blind spots and impossible reaction times
- 2 This is an unlit, narrow, single paved road that has no divider
