Subject:	Attorney's Title Certificate, Certificate of Lands for the Venice Segment of the Sarasota County, Florida Shore Protection Project, Perpetual Beach Storm Damage Reduction Easement and Temporary Work Area Easement for the Beach Renourishment Project

Background:

On December 23, 1993, the City entered into a Local Cooperation Agreement with the Army Corp of Engineers (ACOE) to complete 50 years of renourishment of Venice Beach. The initial nourishment was completed in 1995/1996 in two phases and the first renourishment event was completed in 2005. The ACOE and the City are ready to move forward with the 2nd Renourishment Event scheduled to begin construction in November 2014. In order for ACOE to move forward with award of the construction contract, the City will be required to execute an Attorney's Title Certificate, Certificate of Lands for the Venice Segment of the Sarasota County, Florida Shore Protection Project, Perpetual Beach Storm Damage Reduction Easement and Temporary Work Area. Staff recommends approval and execution of the attached documents.

Motion to Authorize the City Attorney to execute the Attorney's Title Certificate and the Mayor to execute the Certificate of Lands for the Venice Segment of the Sarasota County, Florida Shore Protection Project for completion of the Beach Renourishment Project.
