An Ordinance Amending the Official Zoning Atlas of the City of Venice, Florida, Pursuant to Zoning Map Amendment Petition No. 25-42RZ, to Change the Zoning Designation for the Properties Generally Located at 2100 and 2413 Knights Trail Road from Commercial General (CG) and Commercial Intensive (CI) to Knights Trail Mixed Use (KT); Providing for Repeal of All Ordinances in Conflict Herewith; Providing for Severability; and Providing an Effective Date (Quasi-Judicial)

Planner Brittany Smith, being duly sworn, presented general information, background, project description, aerial map, future land use map, existing and proposed zoning map, surrounding land uses, zoning standards comparison table, consistency with the Comprehensive Plan, compliance with the Land Development Code, findings of fact, and answered Council questions regarding who initiated the application, building coverage, and whether the applicant is aware of the architectural requirements.

Attorney Jackson Boone, Agent, being duly sworn, commented on the applicant's awareness of the architectural requirements, past rezoning application, reason for the request, and compliance with the code.
