Upon review of the above referenced application, staff provides the following review comments:

1. Please provide any colors already chosen for body, trim, and any accents, including the awning.

Colors for the fabric awnings have not been selected as of yet. However, as I mentioned previously, final color will be selected from the list of approved colors you sent us.

2. Please provide a brief response stating how the proposal complies with the building massing requirements in Sec. 7.10.1.A.2.

The existing building was very commercial in nature and was not in the italian Renaissance, Mediterranean Revival, and Northern Italian architectural styles as mentioned in the architectural design standards, so our proposed design has made every attempt to align with this as well as other recently renovated buildings on venice avenue. Our design renderings have already been submitted so that you know the updated design intent.

3. Include a description of the window glazing in the callouts or on the plans somewhere (Sec. 87-7.10.6).

The window information was submitted previously. Please see the window information below.

We have (3) storefront windows that need muntin bars applied to.

Those are the following dimensions:

(2) 9'3" wide x 6'-0" tall. 5 divided lights wide, 3 tall. FeelSafe Direct Set FL# 27616

(1) 12'6" wide x 6'-0" tall. 7 divided lights wide, 3 tall. FeelSafe Direct Set FL# 27616

We have one storefront door (entry to the upper level) that we will likely replace. FeelSafe Outswing Hinged Door FL# 14504

And another that we will need to replace at the rear of the second floor (secondary egress stair at the rear of the building.) FeelSafe Outswing Hinged Door FL# 14504

The other 2 doors (front of the building) can be 6'8" doors and have a transom above. FeelSafe Outswing Hinged Door FL# 14504, FeelSafe Direct Set FL# 27616

4. Please confirm compliance with Sections 7.10.7.D (recesses and/or projections) and 7.10.7.E (decorative features).

Our proposed design complies with Section 7.10.7.D for recesses and projects (having 2 or more of these features).

We have corbels/brackets, colonnade at the building front as well as balconies. And also with 7.10.7.E as complying with F. ornamental relief design (all windows and doors) and B. Recessed Niches – provided at the rear of the building.

5. Indicate which of the railing designs provided will be used for the project.

These were indicated on the drawings/ renderings. They will be aluminum powder coated railings in a "wrought iron belly style" design. Actual railing design is to be determined based on feedback from the ARB meeting scheduled on the 14th of September.



Note: The front entrances appear to be recessed from the rendering, and the rendering does show colors as well, but please make sure these items are very clear on the elevations.

No recesses will be constructed at the front entrance. This is incorrect. Updated elevations will be provided at our meeting on September 14th as directed.
