

EXCERPT FROM THE APRIL 16, 2013 REGULAR MEETING OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION

5. Comprehensive Plan Amendment Petition No. 12-3CP - Update of 5-Year Capital Improvement Schedule - Staff: Scott Pickett, AICP, Senior Planner

(4:08:) Chair Snyder read a memorandum dated April 16, 2013, stated no written communications have been received regarding this petition; and opened the public session.

Mr. Pickett confirmed the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) schedule is a state requirement and the numbers are correct.

Discussion took place on the rebuilding of fire station No. 1, purchase of police cars, eradicating Brazilian Pepper trees, no data for the commission to make a determination, there being no back up materials, staff following the technical input of the budget figures, and the figures being based on the current approved budget.

Mr. Persson reiterated the state requirement to look five years ahead.

Ms. Moore moved based on the staff report and the presentation, the Planning Commission, sitting as the local planning agency, finds this request consistent with the Comprehensive Plan and, therefore, recommends to City Council approval of Comprehensive Plan Amendment Petition No. 12-3CP.
