Please find the following attachments for your review regarding a new special event request, Venice Brewfest, scheduled for Saturday, May 18, in Centennial Park with open to the public hours from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m.:

First time special events are presented to City Council for approval per the current special event policy. Independent of the previous Brew Bash event, 3 Bridge Brewing, a local brewery who focuses on exceptional beer craftmanship and is dedicated to helping local causes by giving back to the community, in partnership with The Twigg, a 501c(3) whose serves the foster care community, will bring in nearly 20 local craft beer breweries, between six to eight food trucks and live music for this one day event. The event hours are intended to bring residents and visors to downtown Venice to align with dining and shopping hours of restaurants and businesses.


The event will predominantly use the west side of the Centennial Park parking lot, the lawn and gazebo and will reserve the east side of the Centennial Park parking lot for VIP guests and vendors. The event holder and event staff will verify appropriate ages for alcohol consumption and provide wrist bands for those ages 21 and over.

The event holder will use Venice Police Department officers, Solid Waste and Public Works services in addition to brining in event volunteers, vendors and additional port o lets.

#### Saturday, May 18 – DAY OF EVENT

  - Walk property to clear and clean event site (if needed)
  - Set up 10 trash receptacles
- 7 a.m.
  - Set up PA system of music
  - Set up ticket tents

  - Vendors begin to arrive, unload and set-up
  - Food trucks begin to arrive and set up
  - Brewery vendors arrive and set-up
- 9 a.m.
  - o Remaining event staff and volunteers to arrive
  - Event holder to provide training for event staff and volunteers

    - how to tell if someone is intoxicated
    - tent ticket training
    - barback and garbage training
