Kelly,

I received a phone call from George Smith at the SOE's office. They received our Resolution No. 2023-33, regarding the election. He noted that Section 4: Polling Places may be impacted by some changes.

The City annexed land which involved one street that impacts precinct 307 – this adds on 307.3 and one street that impacts “431” (adding on “431.3” - I believe he may have meant 435 since there is not a 431 in the resolution).

One of the precincts is impacted by a little over 100 voters and the other only 6.

He stated these voters will vote at the Church of the Nazarene on E. Venice Avenue for this election. It will be a different location in 2024, but the ballot style will reflect the Venice choices.

George stated they are all set and do not need anything from us, but did not know if we may need to update our resolution.
