<b>SUBJECT / TOPIC</b> : Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Grant Agreement No. 22SRP76 – Amendment No. 3			
<b>BACKGROUND INFORMATION</b> : The Tarpon Center Nature Based Flood Mitigation Pilot Project was identified in the Resilience Plan completed in April 2021. The Tarpon Center project elevates the existing seawall to protect the evacuation route in response to high tides and storm surge impacts that limit travel in the roadway. In addition, living shoreline and water quality improvements are included in the project. The Tarpon Center Project has been combined with utilities upgrades scheduled within the corridor to improve efficiency and cost effectiveness.			
The attached Grant Agreement Amendment extends the expiration date of the agreement to March 31, 2026, to allow for project grant documentation closeout.
