



## Fire and Rescue Facts and Figures

Venice has a City Fire Dept. and a County Ambulance Service

A 911 call for a medical issue will get you a County Ambulance  
and a City Fire Truck

**The City Fire Truck annual budget is \$10 Million; the County Ambulance Service costs Venice taxpayers \$2.8 Million**

In 2017, Venice had 3,400 calls; 5 for structure fires and 2,200 supporting the County Ambulance

**Cost per call for the City Fire Truck is \$3,000**

**Cost per transport for the County Ambulance is \$1,000**

Venice now wants to take over the County Ambulance Service
