RESOLUTION NO. 2023-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA ADOPTING A REVISED SCHEDULE OF VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES CONSISTENT WITH SECTION 2-333 OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES; SUPERSEDING RESOLUTION NO. 2023-16; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Venice has a Schedule of Violations and Penalties that identifies the maximum civil penalty for violation of a city code or ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to update and revise the existing Schedule of Violations and Penalties; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-333(d) of the City of Venice Code of Ordinances authorizes city council to adopt and amend a Schedule of Violations and Penalties by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. The whereas clauses above are ratified and confirmed as true and correct.

SECTION 2. The Venice City Council hereby adopts the Schedule of Violations and Penalties attached hereto as "Exhibit A".

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall supersede and replace Resolution No. 2023-16 in its entirety.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its approval and adoption as required by law.
