Stakeholder Group Summary

- 1st Meeting was on February 1, 2019
- Held 12 Meetings
- All In-house work
 - PW, Finance, City Clerk, PIO
- Implemented significant operational changes



1. Approved Rate Increase Schedule:

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FY17=5%; FY18=5%; FY19=5%; FY20=4%; FY21=3%; FY22=1%
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- 2. Approved Recycling Surcharge, to keep recycling program operational
- 3. Prohibited plastic bags from City yard waste collections

- 4. Supported Automation program for Solid Waste and Recycling
- 5. Achieved full automation in January 2020
 - Reduced fleet by 9 vehicles
 - Staffing levels constant for past 4 years

- 6. Supported Single Stream Recycling
- 7. Achieved full single stream collection in January 2020
- 8. Solid Waste Impact fee July 14th 2020
- 9. New cart fees Garbage & Recycling


- 10. Budget Implications for FY21 and future
 - Exceeding reserve minimum for the first time in many years
 - Building Reserve Future Relocation
 - Provide customers with efficient, cost effective services

- 2013 Kessler Survey: 458 responses (<5%)




Q2 Which of the following best describes the type of home you live in? (Please check only one)

Q3 How many people live in your household, including yourself?





Q4 Which option best describes your typical residency in Venice, FL?





Q5 Which option best describes how you utilize your twice-per-week garbage collection?





Q6 Are you satisfied with the current twice-per-week garbage collection?










FY20 RESIDENTIAL ONE-PER-WEEK COLLECTION COSTS

Q7 Would you support reducing the garbage collection frequency to once per week? (The average residential bill would be reduced approximately \$1-\$2 per month.)





Q9 If the City reduced garbage collection to once per week, would you need a larger or additional cart?





Q10 Does your household participate in the City's recycling program (blue carts)?



Q11 How satisfied are you with your new single-stream recycling cart?


