At a past Traffic Advisory Task Force (TATF) meeting a request for changes to the light at Venice Ave. x Harbor was suggested- specifically to add a left turn lane for traffic southbound on Harbor Drive approaching Venice Avenue. I believe that you, Tom Mattmuller and John Veneziano looked at the site and agreed that it was a good idea and worth pursuing. Can you give me an update?

Also the TATF asked about lighted crosswalks in the downtown area. I think we planned to add reflective tape as a short term measure and potentially add lights as part of a downtown street upgrade- if the bond passes. Is that correct?
