SUBJECT / TOPIC: Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)/Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) Public Assistance Grant Agreement – Hurricane IAN

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: FDEM who serves as the pass-through entity for FEMA has provided Grant Agreement Z2926 for Hurricane Ian Pubic Assistance funding. There is currently no dollar amount listed in the grant agreement, however once project worksheets are submitted and reviewed for eligibility, FEMA/FDEM will provide reimbursement and incorporate the dollar amount into the grant agreement in a final amendment.

Typically, FEMA and FDEM will reimburse eligible expenses after insurance reimbursement is determined. Currently, Debris Removal expenses in the City ROW are eligible for 100% reimbursement through December 7, 2022, and 75% after that date. Other eligible expenses will be reimbursed 75% from FEMA and 12.5% from FDEM

This timing of the reimbursement process is unknown at this time due to several levels of FEMA and FDEM reviews. The first reimbursement is expected sometime this fall and will continue into next year or beyond.
