Subject: First Amendment to Interlocal Agreement between City of Venice and Sarasota County Transfer of Certain City and County Maintained Roads

Background: In accordance with the City of Venice Fiscal Year 2016 Adopted Budget, the First Amendment to the Road Transfer Interlocal Agreement has been prepared to revised the funding priority for Road Impact Fees and prioritize improvements at Pinebrook/Edmondson and S. Harbor Dr. at Airport Avenue/Beach Road intersections for funding in the current fiscal year. Both of these intersections were determined to require additional capacity to improve function and safety. In addition, Osprey Street was inadvertently omitted from the original Road Transfer Agreement. Milling and paving of Osprey Street was completed by Sarasota County consistent with the requirements of other local roads that were transferred in the vicinity. The existing Osprey Ditch Drainage Facility is currently operated and maintained by the City based on a previous agreement. Staff recommends execution of the First Amendment to the Road Transfer Interlocal Agreement.

Requested Action: Motion to Authorize the Mayor to execute the First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement Between City of Venice and Sarasota County Regarding the Transfer of County Maintained Local Roads on the Isle of Venice to the City of Venice and the Transfer of a Segment of Laurel Road and a Segment of Pinebrook Road, Including a Bridge, to Sarasota County.
