


## THE NEW FLOOD ZONE MAPS BECOME EFFECTIVE MARCH 27, 2024

over time, so the maps need to be updated periodically. There will be some implications for properties near the Intracoastal Waterway due to a new line called the Limit of Moderate Wave Action. ## EFFECTIVE MAPS

## PENDING MAPS

Any permits submitted on or after March 27, 2024, will be subject to the new maps. Visit venicegov.com keyword search "2024 flood zone map".




Any properties changing from a Special Flood Hazard Area (high-risk) to a non-Special Flood Hazard Area (low to moderate risk) will no longer be subject to the mandatory flood insurance purchase requirements, though some lenders may still require it. The City always recommends the purchase of flood insurance.





The Community Rating System is a program that the City participates in that implements higher standards from FEMA regulations. In return for participating residents receive an automatic 20% discount on their flood insurance premium.
