Dear Mr. Shrum:

Thank you for providing the City of Venice Comprehensive Plan Amendment Petition No. 17-03CP (The Woods at Venice). Please be advised that the proposed comprehensive plan amendment will require an amendment to the Joint Planning and Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement (JPA) between the County and the City of Venice. If the City wishes to pursue an amendment to the JPA, County staff will be prepared to assist in the process.

Section 6.B (4) of the Amended and Restated JPA states:

The Party with jurisdiction over the development application shall require that transportation improvements including the extension of Jackson Road from Border Road to Laurel Road as a two-lane facility will be required to be provided by the developer consistent with the standards in the County's land development regulations.

Deletion of this identified future segment of Jackson Road as proposed in the comprehensive plan amendment necessitates a change to this section of the JPA. Sarasota County's Transportation Planning staff has no objection to the proposed comprehensive plan amendment petition as the segment of Jackson Road, from Laurel Road to Border Road, is not designated on Sarasota County's Future Thoroughfare Plan.
