- Very few empty seats
- Sunday seems to be a good day
- Lots of riders getting on and off at the Jetty and Crow's Nest
- Not many pickups on Tarpon Center Drive, but I don't think folks realize yet that Trolley can be flagged down, and will probably increase
- The left turn from West Venice Ave onto Rt. 41, and left back onto Tampa Ave., is time consuming and yields no riders
- A left turn onto Nokomis Ave. and another left onto Tampa business area, instead of the Rt.41 turn, would be way more productive.
- Skipping Centennial Park and going left on Nassau would shorten the route
- Our Mother's House lot is way too far out and too residential; replacing with Community Center parking--more productive

- Remove Barcelona Ave. and replace with Granada.
