Project Description

The Sarasota County Shore Protection Project is located between DEP monuments R116 and R133 in Sarasota County. The federal project design includes a minimum design berm that is intended to provide the primary storm damage buffer to the upland property. When erosion encroaches significantly into this minimum width, it is an indication that periodic maintenance is needed. Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Permit No. 0211217-005-JC, issued to the City of Venice and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) as co-applicants, authorizes the placement of maintenance fill within the Venice Beach Shore Protection Project. The requested funds are for Design & Construction (USACE Multiphase), Yr 1 Monitoring, and Yr 2+ Monitoring. Staff have determined that 100% of the project is eligible for state cost sharing.
