Discussion of Potential Text Changes to Chapter 87 Section 7

Discussion took place regarding Section 1.1.3, the board's membership composition, the representative of Venice MainStreet, Certified Local Government (CLG) guidelines, and providing Council guidance on appointing members to the Historic and Architectural Preservation Board (HAPB).

Discussion continued regarding Section 7.2 and 7.3, HAPB's role in CLG standards, concerns about budget ramifications, the local register and

National Register of Historic Places, and having the board review owner requests versus the Historical Resources Manager.

Discussion took place on the Venetian Theme District, removing the exclusion of single-family homes, owner approval, property rights, and the City's inability to impose stricter requirements per state law until after October 1, 2026.

Discussion took place on Section 7.7, local register and landmarks, items that property owners may request to be included in the Local Register of Historical Resources, and Section 7.8 and the proposal to add Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties.

Senior Planner Tremblay stated Section 7.8.1, Certificate of Architectural Compliance (CAC) Guidelines, had already been fixed.

Discussion continued regarding the next steps and the legislative referral process.
