SUPPORTS STRATEGIC PLAN: Goal Three: Ensure a Fiscally Sound City

SUBJECT / TOPIC: Budget Amendment #2 for Fiscal Year 2024

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The City of Venice, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, adopted its fiscal year (FY) 2024 operating budget, revenues and expenses, and capital improvement program by approving Ordinance No. 2023-34 on September 25, 2023 for \$175,493,956. The City Council can amend the budget as necessary throughout the year by adopting an amending ordinance in the same manner as the original budget adoption.

The FY2024 budget was increased by certain encumbrances (\$46,910,132) and project balances (\$43,405,075) rolled forward from FY2023. Encumbrances represent the balances on certain purchase orders at September 30, 2023. Project balances are when a project has been approved in FY2023, but a contract has not been finalized or encumbered. The Fiscal Year budget was amended by approving Ordinance No. 2023-55 on December 12, 2023 which decreased total revenue and expenditures by \$16,345,000, said budget as amended being \$249,464,143.

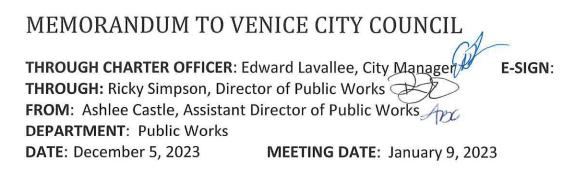
In addition, certain additional expenses were not anticipated at the time the original FY2024 budget was adopted or amended. The City desires to amend its FY2024 adopted budget by \$248,394. \$193,794 of this amount is to appropriate funds to replace the Air Handling Units for the City Hall HVAC system as identified on the attached memo from the Director of Public Works, and \$54,600 is to appropriate funds for three EMS Lucas Devices and CPR Training Kits as identified on the attached memo from the Fire Chief. The proposed amended budget for FY2024 is \$249,712,537 as shown in the schedule on page 2.

SUBJECT / TOPIC: Budget Amendment to Replace Four (4) Air Handler Units for City Hall HVAC System

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Public Works is actively working on numerous solutions to fix and address all the issues we continue to face with the HVAC system located at City Hall. With that, over the last few months we have worked extensively with Hall Mechanical and Air Conditioning, to conduct a test and balance study to identify all areas of the deficiencies. The report has been reviewed and the initial set of enhancements and repairs are underway to upgrade the current control systems to a new wireless program, add outside air dampers, and deep clean all coils within the current air handling units.

Based on the findings from Hall Mechanical it was also noted that all four air handling units (AHU) are old, outdated and pieced together from previous mechanical failures and are no longer appropriately servicing the system and need to be replaced for the system to operate as designed. The location of these units makes in nearly impossible to just replace one at a time and the labor cost associated with doing that would increase the financial burden on the City and also decrease the effectiveness of the system for a longer period of time. Given the age and deteriorating state of the current AHUs, trying to replace them one at a time would also drastically increase the maintenance cost of the ones remaining just to keep them operational.

The lead time on units of this size and caliber ranges anywhere from 30-40 weeks and it is the recommendation of the Public Works Department to move forward with securing the new units as soon as possible. Based on all the information and data gathered in the last few months, the replacement of these AHUs is essential to the overall function of the HVAC system.
