





- I. Wisdom shall take nothing from this action;
- J. This Court reserves jurisdiction to award Defendants prevailing party(s) costs; and
- K. This Final Judgment concludes all judicial labor between the Parties on all substantive issues in this litigation. The only remaining issues are the amount of costs Defendants are entitled to as the prevailing parties.





TO NEW WATER RETENTION PONDS



I am submitting this letter to respectfully request that you decline the proposed development by Meritage Builders/Developers that will be adjacent to the Toscana Isles Community for a multitude of reasons. I own property in Toscana Isles, and I can attest climate change and increasing developments have caused several issues. Venice and Toscana Isles have faced flooding, water restrictions, and growing congestion as new developments bring more cars and inhabitants to the area. All cities and towns have a carrying capacity, and building above that carrying capacity can lead to significant negative consequences for the entire city or town and for all those that live here. More developments with a limited water supply will only exacerbate our water shortage, and it could literally and figuratively drain the life out of our fragile ecosystem.

In addition to the above, Toscana Isles maintains its own roads, and from what I was told the proposed development is somewhat landlocked. If approved, a new development near Toscana Isles may allow some traffic to pass through the community. Since Toscana Isles is responsible for maintaining its own roads, any extra traffic will increase the wear and tear on these privately managed roads, which are funded through our Reserve Fund. In addition, I was told the developers are now pushing for alternative routes to allow the future residents in the proposed development to enter and exit the development by driving through a construction area business which will be a precarious situation for residents and anyone driving in that area. In addition, more cars in an already busy area will inevitably cause more congestion.

The Venice City Planning Committee decisively rejected the proposed development. I therefore am asking each of you to reject the proposed development too.

I created an online petition titled: Prevent development adjacent to Toscana Isles. Within weeks, 735 people signed the petition urging the Venice City Council to reject the proposed development. Many families have invested their savings in homes at Toscana Isles, and many are concerned that the new development will negatively impact the community's quality of life. Houses will without question depreciate significantly if this proposal is allowed. More flooding will result in higher insurance values for all of us. If the proposed land is paved over the vacant land that absorbs water will become impervious when cement and asphalt is located on the proposed site. In Toscana Isles, we have natural lakes such as Lake Awesome, and the weir will potentially have issues with its functionality if the lake is inundated with more water during major storms. More water that cannot be absorbed into the ground water will lead to more flooding and related flood damage, and that will result in more insurance claims. We

only have to consider the number of insurance companies that left the State of Florida when we were hit with previous devastating storms.

I created a Facebook Page titled: Toscana Isles Houses for Sale, Rentals, Pending Sales, and Recently Sold. I've noticed prices falling because some realtors and buyers informed me they heard the proposed development might be approved.

Kindly review the online petition and, in consideration of the reasons outlined both here and within the petition, I respectfully ask you to decline the approval of the proposed development.

I am writing to urge you to deny the proposed Ordinance No. 2025-46. My wife and I are residents in the adjacent Toscana Isles community. We oppose this ordinance not just because of the ordinary "not in my backyard" mentality, but because of the following very specific and unique issues.

- 1) Toscana Isles is built amongst a series of storm water drainage lakes. Stormwater runs through these lakes and runs directly through a weir located on the land in PID#0366-13-0002. Past experience in major storms has shown that failure to keep that weir system cleaned out and operating as designed could result in significant flooding of the homes in Toscana Isles. During Hurricane Ian several years ago, the malfunctioning of that weir system resulted in water being prevented from flowing out of the Toscana Isles lake system and coming within an eyelash of flooding the homes here. We are extremely concerned that the proposed development would interfere with this finely balanced drainage system and increase the chances of flooding during major storm events.
- 2) It's our understanding that this proposed development would be given access through our community's secondary entrance gate. If true, that would aggravate an already troublesome security situation in the Toscana community. Any action that restricts, alters, or places additional strain on that outlet poses a direct negative impact on public safety, flood prevention, and environmental stability.

To put the risk into perspective:

- A one-foot rise in lake levels equals approximately 66 million gallons of excess water that must exit through that single channel.
- Blocking, narrowing, or encroaching upon this drainage infrastructure—even unintentionally creates a high probability of flooding that would affect homes, roads, wildlife corridors, and surrounding natural areas.

Toscana Isles residents maintain this lake system at our expense, and it currently functions in accordance with approved engineering and environmental standards. Development on or around the outlet channel threatens that integrity. Once altered, the damage cannot be reversed—especially in a region already vulnerable to heavy rainfall, storm surge, and increasingly unpredictable weather patterns.

It is worth noting that the **Planning Commission already voted to deny this request** after careful evaluation. Their decision reflects both the technical realities and the community concerns, and I urge the Council to uphold that decision.

This is not opposition to growth—responsible development has an important place in Venice. However, development that jeopardizes critical water infrastructure, public safety, and long-term environmental stability should not move forward.

For these reasons, I respectfully ask that you vote against the appeal and reject the zoning change and development request for Tract 17.

Council Members,

I'm asking that this City Council vote NO on the proposal already voted down by the Planning Commission regarding the access from Jean Green Rd for the building of townhouses in Tract 17. It's known that a city Council composed of elected officials can choose to except or reject recommendations based on various factors including political considerations, economic benefits (money,) or different interpretations of technical data even in the face of expert advice and resident opposition. This dynamic often leads to tension between expert opinion, community concerns, and political will. Even though council members live on the island, outlying areas and voters of Toscana Isles have issues being brought to you that need to be thoroughly considered.

I also spoke at the planning commission meeting regarding this issue and provided a packet to each member and a poster of the FEMA map for review regarding flood zones. Specifically flood zone AE10 that includes several homes in Toscana Isles along with the No-Rise Certification and the Nuisance Lawsuit. (Refer to that documentation)

FEMA designated Toscana Isles to be situated in an AE 10 flood zone area. Such a designation requires additional thought and consideration to those already living in such an area. This designation was done prior to all the other building you have recently approved in and around Toscana currently. No one can predict what impact this new construction over the past year or two will have on our community since the FEMA designation. However, to approve a multi unit build in the AE10 flood zone area and where the natural flow of water, from the Myakka river, the Venetian Golf Club, and Willow Chase who currently dump water into our ponds and through our weir flowing out to the Gulf, can only negatively impact our community. When you block that natural flow with this proposal in front of you, it is setting up the Toscana Isles community of over 900 + homes to flood even more than FEMA has already specified to be an issue. Not to mention Venetian and Willow Chase could potentially be impacted with flooding that could get backed up as well.

A proposed development in the University city of Missouri was voted on as against the project due to flooding concerns by the city stormwater commission. The city Council overrode their recommendation. Since then the area has experienced significant flooding in 2008 and in 2022. Even though the city Council makes the final vote, it may not always be in the best interest of the residents or the city to do so. A yes vote, by the City Council in this Missouri community devastated the neighborhood and issues are still ongoing 17 years later for residents and legal battles against the city.

Let me end with this, FEMA states and I quote "that New Development in floodways is extremely restricted". In short, building in a floodway is typically off-limits, unless the project causes ZERO impact on flooding. Often communities simply prohibit, floodway

construction altogether aside from minor improvements, due to liability and technical difficulty. Yet, they specifically state that the floodway itself must remain unobstructed."

My hope is that this City Council may learn from other city councils and avoid a backlash of technical and legal battles by its planning commission that already voted this proposal down. Even though Toscana Isles residents may not live on the Island we are residents and voters within the city of Venice.



Is Explosive Growth Putting North Venice at Risk of Widespread Flooding?

By Sue Perry, Director Venice Voice, Toscana Isles HOA Board member

Summary

Rapid development in North Venice is raising serious flooding and safety concerns, as essential stormwater systems and community infrastructure face increased pressure from new construction. Residents are urged to take action, attend council meetings, and advocate for responsible growth to protect their neighborhoods.

Main Points

New development is replacing permeable land with paved surfaces, which dramatically increases runoff during storms. This means less water is absorbed into the ground, heightening the risk of flooding for current residents. As more land is developed, the city's infrastructure becomes more vulnerable to extreme weather events.

Stormwater from thousands of homes and businesses is funneled into a single, aging weir located on Tract 17. This overburdened system is already struggling to manage the massive volumes of water from existing communities, and further development will only add to the strain, potentially causing failures and widespread flooding.

Recent development proposals, such as Wisdom Townhomes, have ignored critical infrastructure needs, including sidewalks for schoolchildren and the 50–60 ft setback required near the Toscana Isles North Entrance. These oversights compromise the safety and accessibility of the neighborhood, raising concerns for both residents and city planners.

The plan to build on Tract 17 (next to Toscana Isles) could undermine flood mitigation efforts, especially since Sarasota County's petition to preserve this parcel as wetlands remains unresolved. Wisdom's sudden move to "find" a buyer for the parcel containing the weir adds another layer of uncertainty, as building over such a vital stormwater system with failed mitigation areas is almost certain to lead to problems.

Given the limitations of city and county resources, officials have advised residents to obtain flood insurance and take personal precautions. This guidance signals that institutional protection may be insufficient and that community members must be proactive in safeguarding their homes.

The Planning Commission Denies Wisdom Townhomes Proposal

Main Reasons for Denial

Single Access Point:

1. The planned development included only one access point to Gene Green Road. With the anticipated volume of resident vehicles and the frequent use of the road by commercial tractor trailer trucks, having just one entrance and exit raised significant safety concerns. Additionally, Gene Green Road is a private road, and its use for community traffic was questioned in terms of appropriateness and safety.

Stormwater Drainage and Flooding Risks:

 The proposal called for constructing a bridge over the main stormwater drainage ditch that serves the surrounding properties. Members of the commission were concerned that this bridge could impede the flow of water, potentially leading to flooding in the area.

Residents are strongly encouraged to voice their concerns regarding flooding and overdevelopment at the Venice City Council meeting on December 9th at 9:00 AM. Collective action is needed to ensure that the city prioritizes safety and sustainable growth over unchecked expansion.

For those interested, please join Toscana Isles residents in their effort to oppose the Wisdom 50-unit Townhome rezoning request at the December 9,2025 at the 9:00 am meeting at Venice City Hall.

It is our hope that our City Council takes a hard look at the flooding and traffic issues that already exist due to the extensive development in the Knights Trail/Laurel Road area and subsequently supports the denial decision already made by the City's Planning Commission.



When we get heavy rain, there are torrential rivers running down the 2 streets and the water disappears into the grates and runs into the channel at the end of the street. The channel that the builders want to build through, because it is the only way they can access that land.

It is well documented in this ordinance's processing history that this channel is the only thing that is stopping our entire community, and several others, from getting destroyed by flooding in these torrential rains. Lakes drain into it as well. Everything runs through this 15 foot wide channel.


