SUBJECT / TOPIC: Floodplain Management Plan Yearly Report

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Annually, a progress report is prepared for the Floodplain Management Plan (FMP). The annual progress report for the City of Venice Floodplain Management Plan was prepared by the CRS Committee on February 6, 2024.

The following is a summary of activities completed as outlined in the CRS Annual Verification guidelines:

- As stipulated in the Floodplain Management Plan, this annual report, as submitted to City Council, will be generally made available to the public. It can be requested from the Engineering Department or can be found online at venicegov.com, and search "Floodplain Management Plan." The needs and goals of the community, pertaining to hazards and risks, have not changed substantially since the adoption of the FMP on April 25, 2023. The FMP will expire April 25, 2028.
- All new construction and substantial improvements are required to comply with the
 city floodplain ordinance and construct above the 100-year floodplain elevations. The
 Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD) also requires that floodplain
 compensation calculations be completed to reduce any off-site floodplain impacts.
- The population numbers were updated based on the US Census annual estimations available.
- As part of the continuing effort to complete mitigation projects and obtain grant funding assistance, the Local Mitigation Strategy (LMS) project list was updated to highlight projects completed in the last year and added future projects. The updated LMS project list is incorporated into the FMP as an update to the Sarasota County LMS Plan.
- No additional updates of the floodplain ordinance have been completed this year.
- Additional outreach was conducted to clarify to condominium owners that the association building coverage does not cover their contents. There was increased public

access and clarification of flood maps, clearer messages in the PPI about site visits, the provision of mitigation assistance and property flood protection measures and the creation of additional outreach materials for social media. General outreach to the residents was also completed through utility bill inserts. The desired outcomes of the PPI and CIP activities remain "community awareness and increased flood insurance coverage in the SFHA". Currently, the committee sees no need to revise these outcomes.

- The community remains a class 6 community and continues to review the CRS program against our most recent audit results, making changes to the CRS program and FMP as deemed necessary and beneficial for both CRS scoring and the community in general. As a class 6 community, our residents receive a 20% on their flood insurance premium.
- The LMS project list has been updated to reflect completion of project and additional projects for consideration for future grant funding. The Floodplain Management Plan has been updated to include adoption of the Sarasota County Multijurisdictional Program for Public Information. Using this county-wide approach for public outreach and increased insurance coverage will maximize the resources available to the City while reducing duplicated costs. The committee will continue to meet quarterly to evaluate opportunities to improve the effectiveness of the floodplain management and outreach activities.
