RESOLUTION NO. 2014-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA, CREATING AN EMPLOYEE SAFETY COMMITTEE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the city has established a safety committee that recommends improvements to the city's overall safety program and identifies corrective measures needed to eliminate or control recognized safety hazards; and

WHEREAS, the committee is comprised of representatives of each union, management employees and insurance carrier/agent representatives who evaluate the effectiveness of control measures used to protect employees from safety and health hazards in the workplace; and

WHEREAS, the committee will be responsible for assisting management in updating the workplace safety program by evaluating employee injury and accident records, identifying trends and patterns and formulating corrective measures to prevent recurrence, and assist in monitoring workplace safety education and training that is effective and documented; and

WHEREAS, the committee will assist management in evaluating employee accident and illness prevention programs, and promoting safety and health awareness and coworker participation through continuous improvements to the workplace safety program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. Established. There is hereby established an Employee Safety Committee, herein referred to as the "Committee". The director of administrative services shall appoint the members and determine the terms of office.

SECTION 2. Duties and Responsibilities. The Committee will participate with city staff and consultants to promote safety and health awareness through continuous improvements in the workplace.

SECTION 3. Compensation. Members shall receive no compensation for their service on the Committee.

SECTION 4. Meetings. Meetings of the Committee shall be called and scheduled by the director of administrative services. The Committee shall comply with all applicable requirements of Florida's Sunshine Law, Public Records laws, the Code of Ethics and all city policies for public representatives.

SECTION 5. Removal. Members serve at the pleasure of the director of administrative services and may be removed from the Committee by the director of administrative services at any time with or without cause.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
