Robin Parsons, event coordinator, spoke to the non-profit that she is working with this year, benefits of having the event in the city, and economic drivers, and responded to council questions regarding costs for the event, and the use of city resources.

Mr. Clark responded to council questions regarding public works fees, and police and security protection costs.

Discussion followed regarding miscellaneous charges for clean-up, and donations to Venice wildlife.

Ms. Parsons stated that she is open to the use of non-profits within the city for next year's event.

A motion was made by Council Member Anderson, seconded by Council Member Bennett to approve Item No. 15-1238. The motion carried on voice vote with Mr. Daniels opposed.

Discussion followed regarding including in the bid process the use of Venice dumpsters to avoid additional wear and tear on city streets.
