SUBJECT: Budget Amendment #4 for Fiscal Year 2021

Background: The City of Venice, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, adopted its fiscal year (FY) 2021 operating budget, revenues and expenses, and capital improvement program by approving Ordinance No. 2020-21 on September 22, 2020 for \$128,048,942. The City Council can amend the budget as necessary throughout the year by adopting an amending ordinance in the same manner as the original budget adoption.

The FY2021 budget was increased by certain encumbrances (\$24,141,274) and project balances (\$14,390,590) rolled forward from FY2020. Encumbrances represent the balances on certain purchase orders at September 30, 2020. Project balances are when a project has been approved in FY2020, but a contract has not been finalized (or encumbered). The Fiscal Year 2021 budget was also amended by approving Ordinance No. 2020-41 on December 8, 2020 for \$299,960, said budget as amended being \$166,880,766. The City also reduced its projects by \$2,183,331 to \$12,207,259 and amended its Fiscal Year 2021 budget by approving Ordinance 2021-08 on Februrary 23, 2021 for \$103,538, said budget as amended being \$164,800,973. The Fiscal Year 2021 budget was also amended by approving Ordinance No. 2021-15 on May 11, 2021 for \$18,396,080, said budget as amended being \$183,197,053.

In addition, certain additional expenses were not anticipated at the time the original FY2021 budget was adopted or amended. The City desires to amend its FY2021 adopted budget by \$558,347. \$275,000 of this amount is for a mobile command unit that will be removed from the FY2022 budget, plus \$15,000 for software and hardware for the unit. \$107,847 is to appropriate the revenues and expenditures for a COVID-related DOJ grant for the Police Department identified on the attached memo from the Police Chief. \$160,500 is for additional appropriation for capital improvement projects, as identified on the

attached memos from the City Engineer and Public Works Director, and Attachment "A" of Ordinance No. 2021-27. The proposed amended budget for FY2021 is \$183,755,400 as shown in the schedule on page 3.

SUBJECT: Budget Amendment Request - Lord Higel Parking Lot

Background: Construction of the Lord Higel Parking Lot is an integral part of the City Hall expansion project. This parking area will provide employee parking and access to the Lord Higel House. Based on an analysis of the parking lot use, it was determined the costs would be distributed between Fund 116 (Building Department Enterprise Fund) and Fund 301 (General Capital Project) at 2/3 and 1/3 ratio, respectively. Construction was delayed to avoid conflicts with the Fire Station #1 and City Hall Project. To facilitate completion of the project, Willis A. Smith, Inc., obtained three quotes with the lowest, responsive quote in the amount of \$274,027. Willis Smith will act as the construction manager and will provide services in conjunction with the active construction.

Due to an increase in construction costs, additional funding in the amount of \$102,000 is required for a total project cost of \$302,000. The budget amendment distribution will be \$68,000 from Fund 116 and \$34,000 from Fund 301. This amendment includes awarding the construction contract along with a 10% contingency for unanticipated field conditions and engineering certifications required. Staff recommends approval of this Budget Amendment.

Requested Action: Approval of Budget Amendment to complete construction of the Lord Higel Parking Lot in the amount of \$102,000 allocated from Fund 116 (\$68,000) and Fund 116 (\$34,000).

SUBJECT: Budget Amendment Request - Venezia Park Improvement Project

Background: Venezia Park, located at 450 Nassau Street, was part of a comprehensive public outreach process in 2020, which was performed to determine the needs for the park and surrounding community. Following the public outreach, the City performed the design and permitting of the park improvements. These improvements include a 6 ft. wide walking/exercise trail, new ADA curb ramps, cross-walks and landscaping throughout the park. These improvements are based on the results of the public outreach process and are intended to complement the existing trees and playground within the park.

The City issued the request for quotes package on June 1, 2021 to nine (9) local contracting companies and received back three quotes. The lowest responsible quote was in the amount of \$244,062.50 from A.W. Hughey Construction Services Inc. The FY21 budget appropriation available for this project is \$185,594.31 in Park Impact Fees. The County is agreeable to authorizing additional Park Impact Fees to allow the completion of this project in the amount of \$58,500.00.

This increase in construction costs is due to an industry wide inflation of materials and workforce shortages. Staff recommends proceeding with the budget amendment to allow for the improvements to be installed as designed, without having to remove major elements from the project.

Requested Action: Approval of Budget Amendment in the amount of \$58,500.00 from Fund 301 to complete the Venezia Park Improvement project construction.
