Whereas, The American Association of University Women, Venice Branch, is celebrating its 50th year of empowering women and girls in Venice, Florida; and

Whereas, The American Association of University Women (AAUW), officially founded in 1881, is a non-profit, non-partisan organization that enriches and promotes women and girls through advocacy, education, and research.

Whereas, The AAUW Venice has awarded scholarships to women whose education has been interrupted and are returning to complete their degrees; and

Whereas, The AAUW Home Tour, has raised over \$300,000 dollars for this cause; and

Whereas, The AAUW provides opportunities for 8th grade girls to attend Tech Trek, a week-long residential STEM (science, technology, engineering, mathematics) camp; and

Whereas, The AAUW Venice has more than 140 members and is the largest branch in Florida.
