SUBJECT: **Approval of Contract for Eastside WRF Reclaimed Water Filtration Project (ITB # 2985-14) with TLC Diversified, Inc. in the amount of \$1,758,000.**

Background:

At the request of the Utilities Department, Procurement has solicited sealed bids for filter rehabilitation at the Eastside Water Reclamation Facility (WRF). On May 9, 2014, five (5) responsive and responsible bids were received.

Upon evaluation of the bids staff recommends award to TLC Diversified, Inc. of Palmetto, FL, a "local business" as defined in Section 2-211, as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, in the amount of \$1,758,000. A Notice of Intent to Award was issued on May 19, 2014

The Utilities Department has reviewed the bid responses and concurs with this recommendation.

Requested Action:

Approval of the attached contract with TLC Diversified, Inc. in the amount of \$1,758,000 and grant authorization for the Mayor to execute the contract.

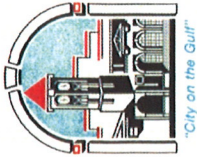

PURPOSE:

On May 9, 2014, the City of Venice held the bid opening for ITB Number 2985-14, Eastside WRF Reclaimed Water Filtration Project. TLC Diversified, Incorporated was the apparent low bidder at \$1,758,000.00. McKim & Creed, Inc. contacted the references provided by TLC as a part of the bidding assistance services provided under Work Assignment No. 5.

DESCRIPTION:

1. **Lockheed Martin Remediation WTP Design/Build** – AECOM – Michael Sutton was the Construction Manager and involved in the design. TLC worked as a mechanical subcontractor to AECOM for the ground water treatment plant. AECOM was responsible for the coordination of all of the disciplines. Installation of process equipment included settling tanks, filters, UV, GAC and a small RO skid for softened water. The schedule and budget were met. Changes were owner directed. TLC maintained an adequate work force. AECOM would use them again. Dollar value of \$1,943,058.00 shown in the experience resume represented TLC portion of the project, overall project was \$30,000,000.
2. **City of Clearwater Facility Improvement Development Areas** – Siemens Inc. – Tony Hasegawa was the Project Manager for Siemens. TLC worked as a subcontractor for Siemens under Siemens contract for facility improvements/upgrades. Mechanical work at the Marshal Street and NE plants included installation of motors, mixers, centrifuge, conveyor, and a Co-Gen at NE. The work was completed on time or early in some cases and within budget. TLC has a contract with Siemens with pricing. Changes were both owner directed and value engineered. TLC maintained an adequate work force and performed excellent work. Siemens would work with them again.
3. **City of Clearwater Salsnes Filters Project** – Tara Kivett was the Project Manager for City of Clearwater. TLC was the prime contractor for the project. The project did not come in on time due to field/design and scope changes. Changes to the project were not excessive in cost. The quality of the work was good. They maintained an adequate work force and the City would work with them again.
4. **City of Clearwater Headworks Screening & Grit Removal** – Lan Anh Nguyen was the Project Manager for City of Clearwater. The work was at all three of the Clearwater plants. There were minor issues with bypassing from the headworks but the project was within the budget but was slightly over in time. The quality of work and work force was good. They continue to do work for the City.

CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT, pursuant to City Council approval granted on _____, is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2014, by and between the CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA, hereinafter referred to as the "City", and TLC DIVERSIFIED, INC., a Florida Corporation, hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor".

W I T N E S S E T H:

THAT FOR and in consideration of the mutual covenants and obligations hereafter set forth, the parties hereto agree as follows:

(1) The contract documents consist of this contract, standard general conditions, supplemental conditions, special conditions, technical specifications, drawings, bid proposal for ITB 2985-14, payment and performance bonds, all of which are hereby made a part of this agreement.

(2) The Contractor shall perform all the work required by the contract documents for the following described project; and shall include installation of the listed items, per bid specifications:

City Bid # ITB# 2985-14: Eastside WRF Reclaimed Water Filtration Project

(3) The work to be performed under this contract shall be completed within **270** days of the issuance of the Notice to Proceed by the City.

(4) The City shall pay the Contractor for the performance of the work, subject to the terms and conditions of the contract documents and any written change orders, the contract sum of: **one million seven hundred fifty eight thousand dollars & 00/100 (\$1,758,000.00).**

(5) Time is of the essence in this contract. In the event that the work is not completed within the required time, then from the compensation otherwise to be paid to the Contractor, the City may retain the sum of **one thousand five hundred thirty-two dollars (\$1,532.00) per day** for each calendar day that the work remains uncompleted beyond the time limit, which sum shall represent the actual damage which the City will have sustained per day by failure of the Contractor to complete the work within the required time, said sum not being a penalty but being the stipulated damages the City will have sustained in the event of such default by the Contractor.

(6) In connection with the performance of work under this contract, the Contractor agrees not to discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, sex, religion, color, or national origin. The aforesaid provision shall include, but not be limited to, the following: employment, upgrading, demotion or transfer, recruitment or recruitment advertising, lay-off or termination, rates of pay or other forms of compensation, and selection for training, including apprenticeship. The Contractor agrees to post hereafter in conspicuous places, available for employees or applicants for employment, notices to be provided by the contracting officer setting forth the provisions of the non-discrimination clause. The Contractor further agrees to

insert the foregoing provisions in all contracts hereunder, including contracts or agreements with labor unions and/or workers' representatives, except subcontracts for standard commercial supplies or raw materials.

(7) This contract and the contract documents constitute the entire agreement of the parties and may not be changed or modified, except by a written document signed by both parties hereto. This contract shall be binding upon the successors and assigns of the parties.





NOW, THEREFORE, THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION is such that if Contractor shall promptly and faithfully perform Contract during the original term thereof and any extensions thereof which may be granted by the City with or without notice to the Surety and during any guarantee or warranty period, including the obligation to correct any latent defects not discovered until after acceptance of the project by the City, and if he shall satisfy all claims and demands incurred under said Contract and shall fully indemnify and save harmless the City, its agents, Engineer and employees from all losses, damages, expenses, costs and Attorney's Fees, including appellate proceedings which it may suffer by reason of failure to do so, and shall reimburse and repay the City all outlay and expense which the City may incur in making good any default, then this obligation shall be null and void; otherwise it shall remain in full force and effect.

PROVIDED FURTHER, whenever Contractor shall be, and declared by the City to be in default under the Contract, the City having performed its obligations thereunder, the Surety may promptly remedy the default, or shall promptly:

- (1) Complete the Contract in accordance with its terms and conditions; or
