Banyan Tree (Ficus benghalensis)

A large tree with a 45" main trunk, several large prop roots, approximately 45' tall with a crown spread of between 80' and 90'. The canopy overhangs Ms. Simon's property and the City's right-of-way.

Health and Condition: Very good with a dense green crown

Location: Front yard with ample room to grow with minimal pruning

Structure: Good. The tree has been well cared for
