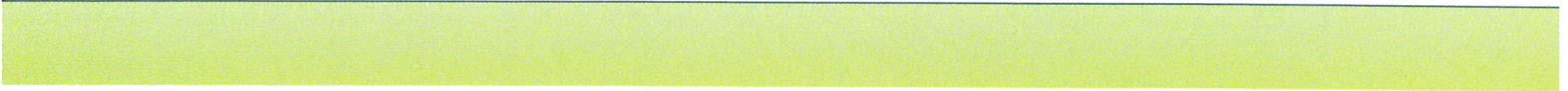

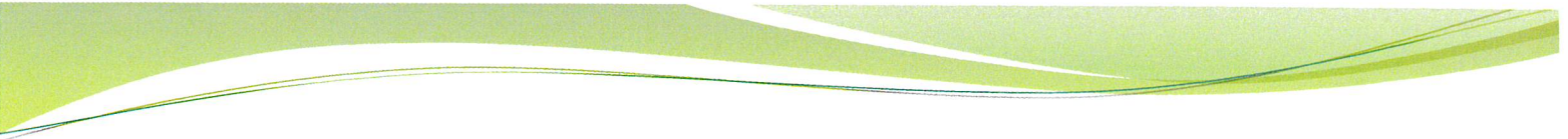

Venetian Tree – 118-10

- Native or Non-native species
- *Significance, desirability, or utility* to the community
- Nominated by property owner where the tree is located
- Written consent to nomination of property owners where branches overhang
- Evaluated by City Arborist
- Designated by City Council
- Permit required to remove



Nominated Tree

Banyan Tree (*Ficus benghalensis*)

A large tree with a 45" main trunk, several large prop roots, approximately 45' tall with a crown spread of between 80' and 90'. The canopy overhangs Ms. Simon's property and the City's right-of-way.

Health and Condition: Very good with a dense green crown

Location: Front yard with ample room to grow with minimal pruning

Structure: Good. The tree has been well cared for

Overall, a good candidates for preservation.
