Troy began his career with the Venice Police Department on October 24th, 1988 and was the first Venice Police Explorer to eventually become a Venice Police officer.

He has always been fully committed to the police department and the community he serves, which is evident by his numerous citizen compliments and professional accomplishments. During his career he has taught new police officers as a field training officer, and served as a departmental defensive tactics instructor and firearms instructor.

He was selected as a canine officer in 1996 while continuing to serve in his various training capacities. During his time as a canine officer he and his K9 partner Kido apprehended numerous suspects and made many drug arrests. He was credited for spearheading the implementation of a Venice Police K9 training facility, which has been used for years by many area agencies.

Troy was ultimately promoted to Sergeant on December 18th, 2006 where he has served with distinction in the Patrol Division on both night and day shifts.
