Definition and Scope

Construct a new facility for the Sarasota County Tax Collector on a 6.5 acre site to include a 9,100 s.f. office building, 80-100 parking spaces, drive-thru service window, vehicle inspection area, driving test range, and appropriate site improvements including utilities, traffic control, and drainage retention.

Rationale

The Sarasota County Tax Collector's office will be providing new Driver License Testing and Vehicle Inspection responsibilities for the State of Florida beginning June, 2015. The existing offices are small and outdated. A new mid-county location for these services will help provide improved and more efficient customer service to the citizens.

Funding Strategy

Interim funding for the property acquisition and initial project costs (up to the beginning of the construction phase) will be provided by an interfund loan from the General Fund, repaid no later than September 2016 with a short term borrow to be repaid with General Fund. In addition to the short term borrow, this project also includes funding provided through General Government Impact Fees (\$1.7 million) for the construction of the facility.
