

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA, REPEALING AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2016-02 SETTING FORTH THE POLICY AND PROCEDURES FOR PUBLIC USE OF CERTAIN MEETING ROOMS IN CITY HALL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, city council established a policy for the use of meeting rooms at city hall in 1999 (Res. No. 99-1) and revised the policy in 2007 (Res. No. 2007-39), and again in 2016 (Res. No. 2016-02); and

WHEREAS, the city has recently completed a new Public Safety Facility, a new Fire Station 1, and is nearing completion of major renovations at city hall; and

WHEREAS, city facilities have meeting room space with differing building access technologies, security levels, and room accommodation designations for use by departments, staff and the public; and

WHEREAS, staff has determined the policies and procedures concerning meeting room use at city facilities are best served administratively.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. The above whereas clauses are ratified and confirmed as true and correct.

SECTION 2. Resolution No. 2021-06 is hereby repealed and rescinded.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall take effect upon adoption, as provided by law.
