

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA, REDUCING THE FEE SURCHARGE OF FOURTEEN PERCENT FOR THE COLLECTION OF PROGRAM RECYCLABLES TO TWO PERCENT; SUPERSEDING RESOLUTION NO. 2021-17; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Section 54-161 of the Code of Ordinances authorizes city council to adopt a surcharge for the collection of program recyclables by resolution; and

WHEREAS, recycling is very important to the local environment by reducing pollution, reducing waste entering landfills and conserving natural resources; and

WHEREAS, the current global economic conditions are still resulting in a low demand and low market value for recyclable materials; and

WHEREAS, the processing, hauling and disposal costs for program recyclable have decreased over the past twelve months; and

WHEREAS, the proposed reduction in the temporary recycling surcharge will still allow the City to maintain a balanced budget and continue recycling operations; and

WHEREAS, this temporary recycling surcharge may be adjusted as needed based upon the future third-party processing and disposal costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. The above Whereas clauses are ratified and confirmed as true and correct.

SECTION 2. This resolution supersedes Resolution No. 2021-17.

SECTION 3. City Council hereby adopts a 2% surcharge, beginning on October 1, 2022, to be added to the current fees for the collection of program recyclables set forth in Section 54-161 of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption, as provided by law.
